(age 5 and under; limit 2; must ride with fare-paying passenger. Additional children under 6 will be charged Youth Fare. Age will be determined by the height of the RED line on the fare box. Children taller than the RED line will pay youth fare.)



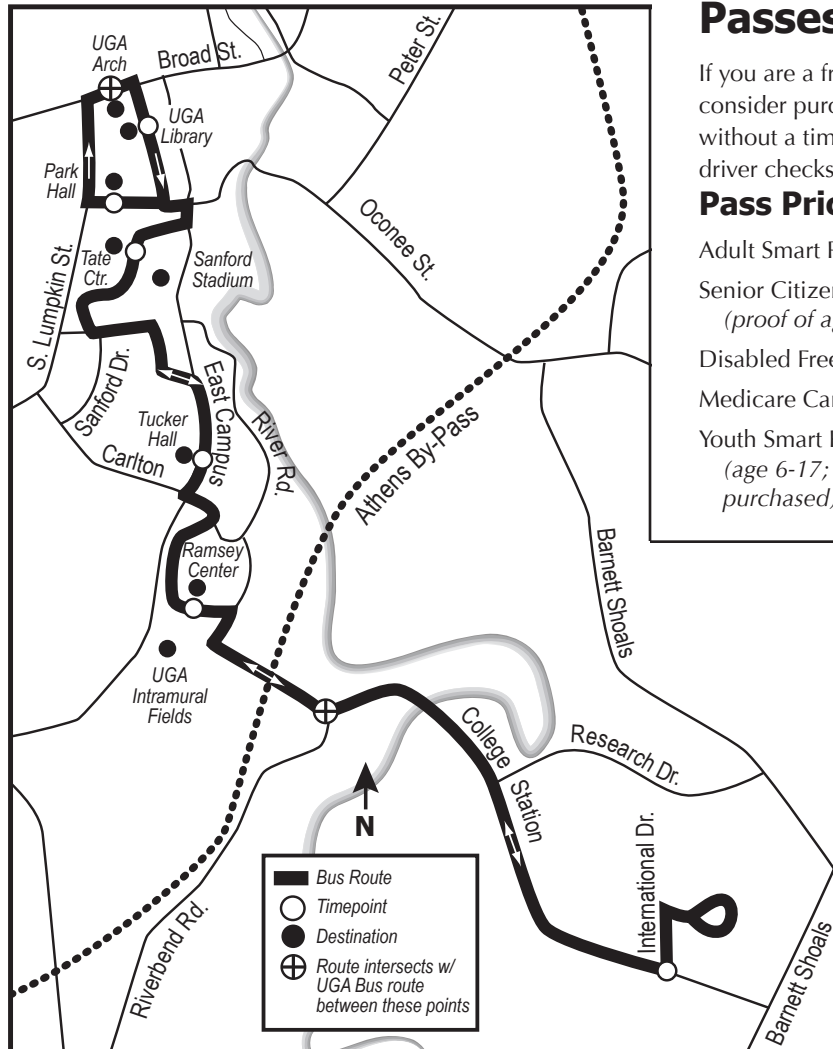
Transfers *(good for connecting bus only)* Free

Passes

If you are a frequent rider of The Bus, you may want to consider purchasing a pass. Each pass covers 22 rides without a time limit. Transfers are issued free when the driver checks the pass.

How to Ride the Bus



- 1 Find your location on the map.
- 2 Check the timetable for the closest timepoint to your location. If you will be catching The Bus at a stop not listed in the timetable, plan to arrive at your stop by the time listed for the preceding timepoint.
- 3 Read the timetable from left to right and top to bottom.
- 4 If you need to take more than one bus to reach your destination, ask your operator for a transfer.
- 5 Use exact fare. The operator cannot make change.
- 6 To indicate your stop, pull the cord located at the top of the windows or press the black strip between the windows.

Bus-N-Bike



ATS "Bus n' Bike" program makes daily commuting much easier, safer, and more convenient for cyclists. Special carriers on the front of the bus allow riders to easily store bicycles while riding. Type the address above into any browser at home or on your mobile device. This takes you to a real-time view of the ATS system on OTvia2™. The location of every bus and stop along all routes is represented on the map. The positions of the buses are updated automatically every few seconds. You can also see the estimated arrival times at each stop. So if you are waiting for a bus or wondering just how close the next bus or bus stop is, check out this app.
